Easter Monday 17th April 2017

The event consists of Men's, Women's and Children's races that take place on Easter Monday. Men carry **50kg** of coal and women **20kg** in weight. All races start from the Royal Oak public house, Owl Lane, Gawthorpe and continue for a distance of 1012 metres to the finish line at the Maypole Green in Gawthorpe village. (Please note your time will be recorded when your load of coal hits the green). Children's Fun Run races start from the Darby Joan, High Street, Gawthorpe and run a short distance of 150 meters (no coal carried). Race coaches are accepted for adult races but **must not be on road during the race** and retire their help at the Boot and Shoe public house in Gawthorpe. Only runners should pass this point. This is to minimise the amount of people in the finish area and for the safety of contestants and spectators. **Failure to do so will result in disqualification of the runner in question.**
